A new regime for accessing government documents begins in early 2010, when the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* is repealed and replaced by the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*. To help our clients make the transition to working under the *GIPA Act*, the Crown Solicitor's Office is offering a half day overview of the new legislation, with a focus on the practical differences between the two regimes. The training will be presented by Anina Johnson, who also runs the popular Introductory and Advanced FOI Training.
